Notable October Activity:

- For the month of October, receipts were lower than expenses.
 - Total offering for the general/building fund for the month was \$39,535. This was lower than budget by \$7,635.
 - Other income (building use, grants, interest, etc.) has been higher than budgeted
 - This is helping us make up for some of the difference from the significant decrease in offering.
 - Expenses are unfavorable to budget this month, but favorable to prior year
- For **October year to date**, receipts are lower than expenses, resulting in a YTD loss of \$93,376.
 - We have seen a good response with several families increasing their online regular giving and one-time gifts coming in for our Faithfully Forward campaign. We have brought in approximately half of our goal for one-time gifts.
 - This goal of \$30,000 is to cover new heating units for the sanctuary and rooms behind the offices as well as repairs of other units. In addition, there are some building and roof repairs that are needed in the very near future as well as a few more trees to be taken down in the parking lot.
 - We are encouraging those who still wish to help bridge the gap to contribute during Give To The MAX
- Cash balances available at the end of September were \$27,101, with an additional \$35,000 in investment accounts.

Pastoral Report- Pastor Glen

I have spent most of my time meeting folks, and already have done a funeral (11-15) and a baptism (11-10). I have had about 10 in-home visits and about a dozen office visits. Almost too many people to remember.

Lots of sadness and even shock here, but most want to move forward and be a church, to members and to Brooklyn Park. I may or not help with the Ministry Site Profile (used to get pastors), as the synod wishes. To answer a much-asked question, I don't know how long I will be here. My longest interim was two and a half years; my shortest was six months.

I want to connect with you and have a conversation with each of you. Folks have been quite welcoming.

PRAISES from PAST Events

- We ended October with a wonderful Affirmation of Baptism service. We had 9 Confirmands this year and their Faith Statement Compilation was phenomenal. We were also able to include all 9 of them in all aspects of the service (Ushering, Greeting, Reading, Communion Serving)
- Trunk-or-Treat was probably our smallest year yet BUT a majority of the young people who attended are NOT members of Prince of Peace. Next year the timing of this event is tricky, so considering reaching out to other Churches about doing one HUGE one instead of a bunch of smaller events
- Our Election Day trip to the Mall of America was a blast. We had 12 youth, and they were so on top of checking in with me definitely something we will think about doing again
- We recently held a game night for Middle School students and 2/3 of the participants were invited by a friend. Game nights are so fun, and so easy and such a convenient way to invite friends to Prince of Peace
- The High School Ministry has had a little bit of a slow start, but on November 10th we had our biggest group yet (our High School students have school/class/teammates who are going through some VERY difficult things, and our HS Time allowed space to talk about that)

CURRENT UPDATES

- We will have a Parents Night Out for Children's Ministry on the 22nd
- Working on the Christmas Program this week. The program will be on December 15th and all Children and Youth ages 3 12th grade will be invited to participate
- We have TWO trips scheduled for High School this coming Summer and information went out last week. Initial registration and deposit are due by December 1st
- Wednesday, December 4th we will be having our ADVENTure Decorating Party and Potluck as well as the Middle School Ministry Christmas Party (that will be the last meeting for Middle School for 2024 as December gets so busy)

- The High School Ministry will meet two more times in 2024: November 24th and then our Christmas Party on December 8th
- Continuing to work closely with Pastor Glen to get things squared away. Currently helping to update some Pastoral Care forms and then will step out and let the Care Team do their work

LOOKING AHEAD

- Children's Ministry will continue to meet on Sunday mornings all the way through December 22nd. On December 1st I will pull them out of Worship IF there are a lot of them, but the plan will be to have the Worship Cart available. The council discussed the 2025 Budget. Giving is low and we need a team effort (Pastor Glen and the Council) to work on the budget. Ideas:
